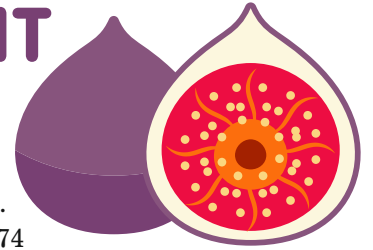

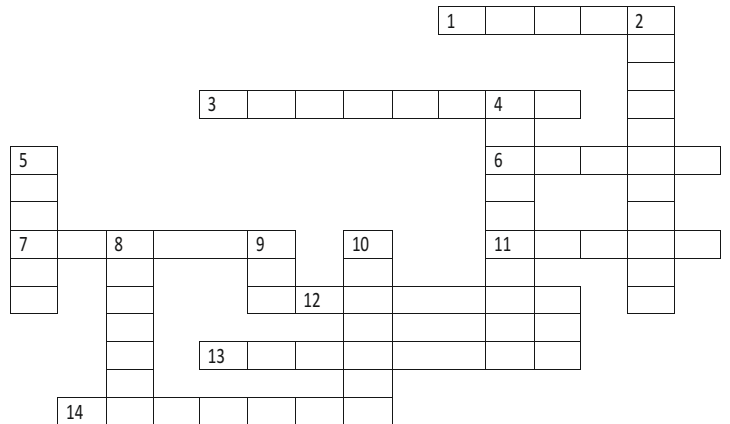
highlighting them. Miss Adverb loves her mother and modifies her when there is a need.

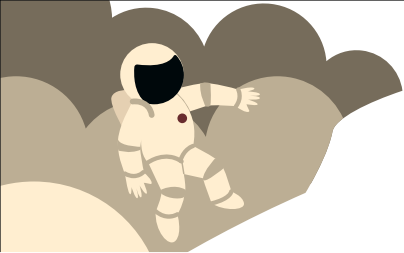

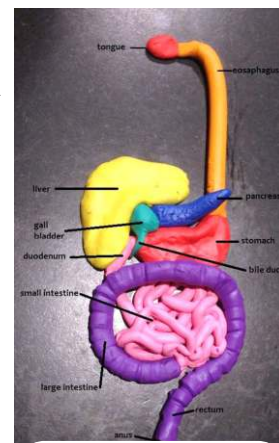

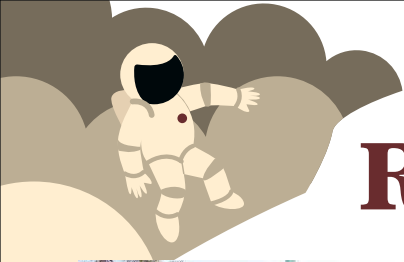
