

## CBSE New Assessment Scheme (2017-18)

pace English Medium School, Jetpur is affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi. After passing class X students are eligible to take admission anywhere in India and other countries. In new scheme of examination, CCE and term system has been replaced with single annual exam by CBSE itself. The exam will be conducted by CBSE for 80 marks and other 20 marks are kept with schools for internal assessment.

#### Benefits of New CBSE Assessment Scheme

- (i) It will reduce stress and anxiety which often builds up during and after the examination which could have an adverse impact on young students especially in the age group of 13-15 years.
- (ii) It will reduce the dropout rate as there will be less fear and anxiety related to performance.
- (iii) It will help to prepare the students for life by making students physically fit, mentally alert and emotionally balanced.
- (iv) It will motivate learning in a friendly environment rather than in a fearful situation.

#### Advantages of CBSE over State Boards

1. CBSE is a lot more student-friendly than State Boards. Its course structure is designed to ensure that students do not face a lot of pressure and books are made interactive and interesting. Also, lots of fun activities are included in between the chapters to help students learn in

a playful way. It makes the whole process of conveying knowledge to the students efficient and healthy.

- 2. CBSE exams are also very conducive to a positive environment for students. All the efforts are taken to ensure that the students actually learn from the entire process. They don't need to mug up things to pass the exams. The papers are designed in such a way that they test how much the students have learnt. The results are mostly favorable and very few students fail in CBSE exams.
- 3. The CBSE curriculum will definitely help you a lot if you are planning to pursue future studies from a centralized institution like an IIT or AIIMS. The preliminary exams for these institutions are organised by CBSE only and therefore you all can get an edge over others if you have done your primary and secondary education in CBSE board.
- 4. CBSE not only imparts quality knowledge to the students but also ensures overall physical and mental growth. It encourages students to pursue sports alongside studies, and a lot of emphasis is given on the physical growth of the children. It also teaches the students to be good citizens of the country and above all good humans.
